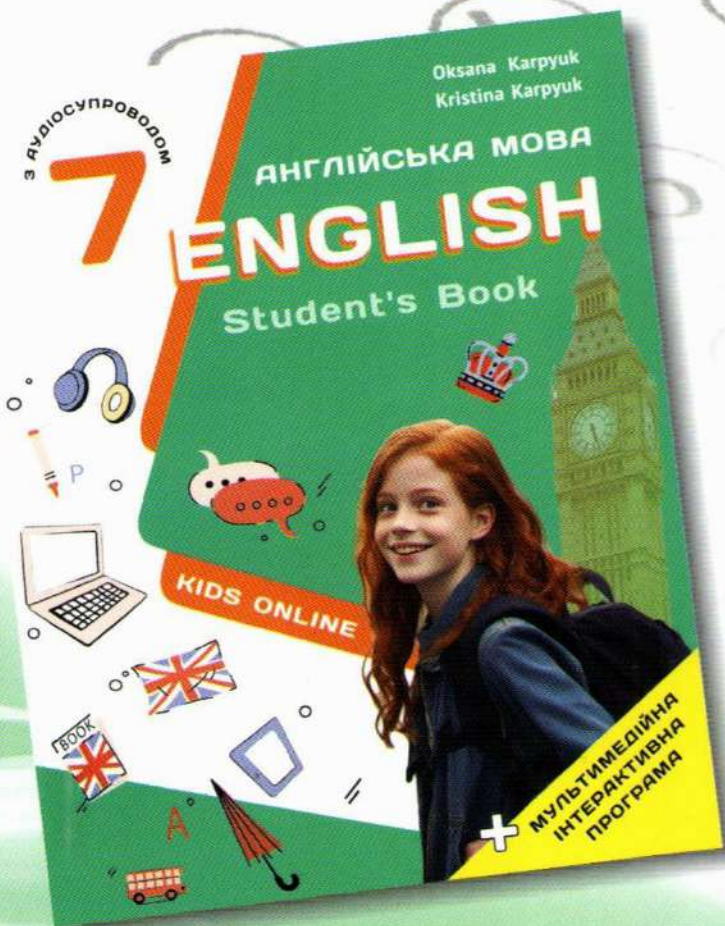

With so many things to see and to do you will never get bored in Washington, D.C. – that's for sure!

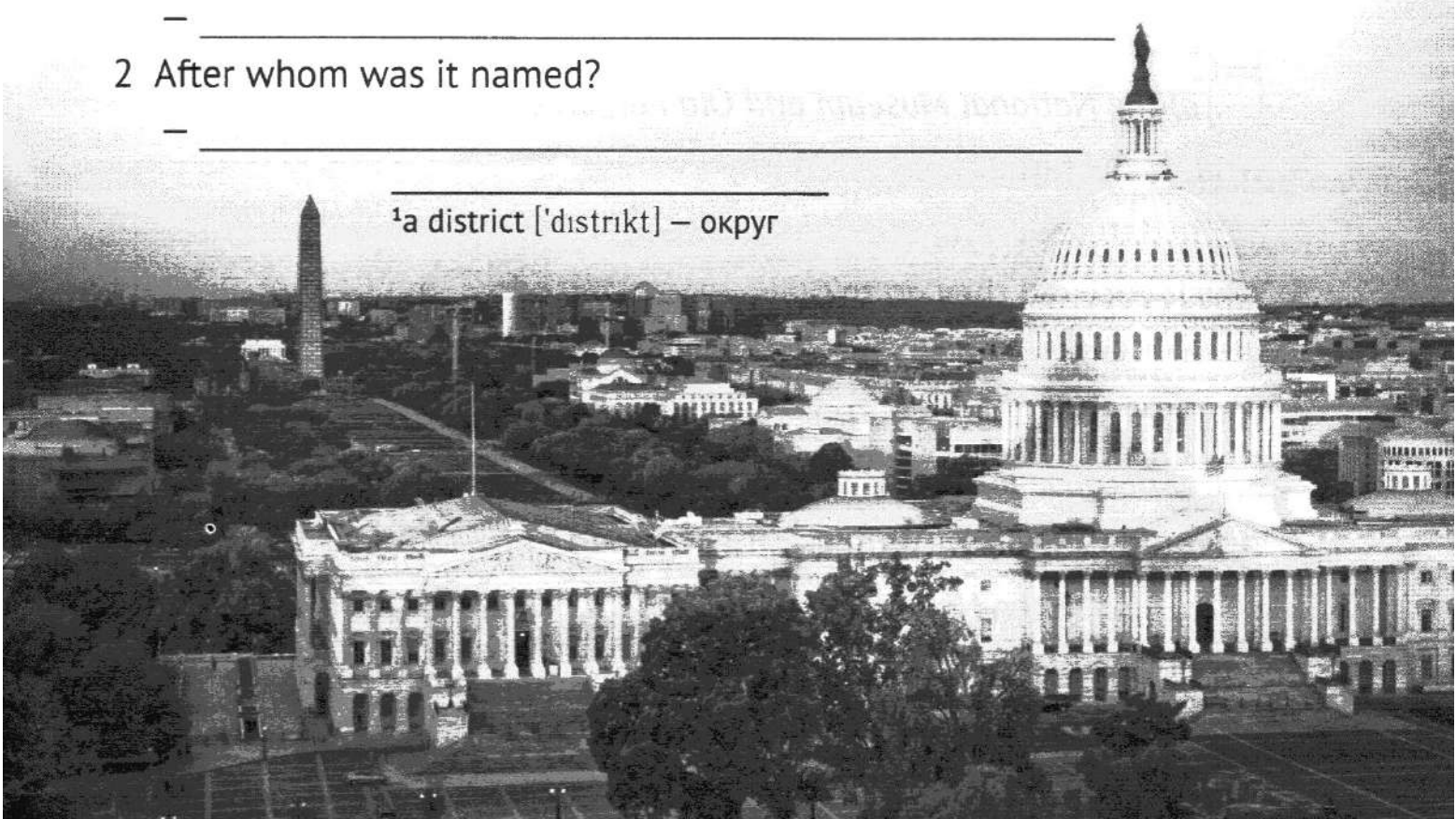
